

The Oklahoma Department of Career and Technology Education in partnership with the Oklahoma Department of Education are pleased to highlight upgrades to Kuder *Connect 2 Business*. C2B is an online platform that connects students and adults alike to businesses in their communities by sharing career opportunities ranging from job shadowing to full-time employment.

Oklahoma high school students are required to complete at least one service learning or work environment activity before graduation. Because the state is

made up primarily of rural communities, service-learning opportunities can be harder to find. CareerTech and the State Department of Education partnership with Kuder makes C2B an all-in-one place to bridge the gap between education and Oklahoma's workforce. While C2B helps high school students find opportunities to fulfil their graduation requirements – it can help both public school teachers and CareerTech instructors find qualified business leaders from their communities to speak to classes or student organizations about specific industries.

C2B also addresses the needs of Oklahoma's adult population by being a resource for internships, apprenticeships and part-time and full-time employment. Oklahoma Department of Career and Technology Education, along with the Oklahoma State Department of Education believes that with *Connect 2 Business* we can encourage career exploration, create community partnership and inspire hope for the future of Oklahoma's workforce.
