EMPATHY - from Young Sheldon

My spouse and I have a tradition that we watch a 30 minute funny TV show before going to bed each night. The rule is that we have to laugh out loud before going to sleep. Right now, we are watching Young Sheldon on Netflix. If you



have ever seen this show you know that Young Sheldon is not in tune with his emotions (that is putting it lightly. ©). He says whatever comes to mind and has little, if any, empathy.

In season 4 or 5 Sheldon decides he is going to show empathy and looks up what that means.... "Give your full attention to what the other person is saying, and try not to interrupt. Ask questions to learn more about the other person, their life, and what they think." He attempts to do this, yet constantly wants to interrupt and correct what people are saying. His dad reminds him that he is supposed to be showing empathy. He eventually has had enough and blurts out what is "right" regardless of the emotional consequences.

So why am I going on about this? As a leader, empathy is one of our greatest powers but what does this actually mean? To truly show empathy we need to listen. Listen to understand, not to speak. Listen to see what the other person sees, not to explain what we see. Listen to acknowledge their reality, not to compare it to our own. Listen to appreciate their perspective, not to challenge it. If we are to truly be empathic leaders we must fully emerge in the conversation and LISTEN.
